

EXERCISE 3.4 - LESSON

GROUP 1: WHITE - WHITE - WHITE

GROUPING MAJOR TRIADS BY SHAPE

Group 1: White - White - White. This group contains three major triads: C major (C-E-G), F major (F-A-C), and G major (G-B-D). Each triad is shown in both treble and bass clefs.

GROUP 2: WHITE - BLACK - WHITE

Group 2: White - Black - White. This group contains three major triads: A major (A-C#-E), D major (D-F#-A), and E major (E-G#-B). Each triad is shown in both treble and bass clefs.

GROUP 3: BLACK - WHITE - BLACK

Group 3: Black - White - Black. This group contains three major triads: Ab major (Ab-Bb-Db), Db major (Db-Fb-Ab), and Eb major (Eb-Gb-Bb). Each triad is shown in both treble and bass clefs.

GROUP 4: EACH HAS A UNIQUE SHAPE

Group 4: Each has a unique shape. This group contains three major triads: Gb major (Gb-Ab-Bb), Bb major (Bb-Cb-Db), and B major (B-D-F#). Each triad is shown in both treble and bass clefs. The triads are grouped by their unique shapes: Black-Black-Black, Black-White-White, and White-Black-Black.
